Saturday, 25th October 2025

Entry Guide Summary:

This supplementary Entry Circular for Surf Boat events is in addition to the overall circular for the 10th Annual Wanda SLSC Tradies One Club Carnival (refer <u>Wanda SLSC</u> and <u>Surf Life Saving Sydney</u> websites).

Clubs are to submit entries online for all events (including surf boats) using the new SLSA Live Heats Entry System manager system. This is accessed via Live Heats Wanda entry link.

Please refer to <u>SLSNSW Circular 3914</u> for detail of the new system. Please note that a club will need to enter their members not already on Live Heats into the system to enable a carnival entry.

The entry Fee is \$65.00 per Boat Crew.

Please note:

- Entries for Surf Boat events open on Friday, 3 October 2025.
- Normal entries for all events close at 12.01am on Monday, 20 October 2025.
- Late Entries will remain open until 12.01am on Saturday, 25 October 2025, but will attract a late entry fee of \$20 per crew.
- Very late surf boat entries may be accepted on the day of the Carnival. On-line entries will remain open until 7.30am. Following that time manual entries will be required and may be taken at the Registration desk that will remain open in Carnival Village until 9:00am. An additional \$15 additional very late entry fee will apply for each crew.

- All entry fees are payable by credit/debit card, or Apple Pay, or Google Pay at the time of entry on the Live Heats system. Please note that a direct funds transfer system is being established by Live Heats but is not expected to be available to use until after 20 October 2025.
- Surf Boat crews do not need live heat wrist bands to participate.

Note: Wanda SLSC must receive all entry fees on or before the date of the Carnival for a Club to be eligible to compete.

The results of the Surf Boat events will be included in the overall Wanda SLS Tradies One Club overall pointscore.

Official Nominations:

To nominate to officiate please use the following <u>link</u> to register and record your preferences. Every effort will be made to accommodate all officials who nominate. Officials will be advised of their appointment and other details following the close of entries.

General Rules:

Surf Boat Competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual plus any relevant Bulletins or Circulars except where detailed in this section.

All Crews are to register on the day of the carnival prior to competing.

All competitors and handlers entering the water beyond knee depth shall be required to wear distinctive high visibility vests (singlets) as their outer layer of clothing or other dress at the discretion of the Boat Referee in consultation with the Competition Committee and Sydney Branch Boat Panel.

SLSS Surf Boat Series Supplementary Rules:

Rule 1:

A sweep is permitted to sweep another club's crews (in addition to their own crews), if required, using their own Club boat or the other Club's boat at the sweep's discretion (providing the sweep is not sweeping an existing crew in the same division). The crews will be entitled to gain Boat Series Points - minus 20% of points awarded.

Rule 2:

The Boat Panel has the right to choose the format of racing on the day considering surf conditions. Although every effort will be made to notify competitors and officials of the format at the earliest opportunity. e.g., flat days perhaps have longer racing (1K) with harsher cuts, or on good clean surf days, race short course with softer cuts to allow more time spent in the surf.

Note: This rule will not apply to the State Selection Carnival at North Cronulla nor the Branch Championships where normal racing will apply.

Rule 3:

U/23 rowers are permitted to row in the U19 age category, on the condition that they do not exceed the combined total age of 76 years (excluding the sweep), provided that no member of the crew is older than the U/23 Category and that there are no more than two over-age rowers in the crew. e.g., two 16-year-old could form a crew with two 20-year old rowers.

Rule 4:

Allowances will be made for crews be made up of rowers from varying clubs. All rowers in such crews must be financial for the 2025/2026 season and be eligible to compete for their own club e.g., two rowers from one club, two rowers from another club plus one sweep. All such crews are eligible to gain points for that specific crew in the SLSS Surf Boat Series. The rowers entry fees are to be paid by own club.

Rule 5:

The SLSS Surf Boat Series cumulative point score will be calculated after at the end of competition using the Round Robin point score detailed in SLSA's SSM for Round Robin competition i.e., 10 points for 1st, 9 for 2nd, etc.

Rule 6:

In addition to Rule 5, crews in the Masters 180 years plus category will be handicapped for the purposes of the Sydney Boat Series cumulative Point Score i.e., one (1) additional point will be added to the finish placing for crews that are aged 200 years plus, two (2) points for 220 plus, three (3) points for 240 plus, and four (4) points for crews that are aged 260 years plus e.g., a 220 plus aged crew places 3rd at Wanda will receive 8 points (3rd) + 2 points = 10pts for series pointscore.

- Inten Reserve, GMP U23, Thirriwirri * U19 and GMP 180 plus Masters Men and Women Surf Boat Races Towels * for members of the 1st place crews.

The cash prizes will be credited to the club of the winning men's and women's Open crews.

Boat Area Location, Trailers, and Parking:

Surf and beach conditions permitting the boat events will be conducted between the Wanda and Elouera Clubs.

Trailers may be unloaded in front of Elouera SLSC and carried onto the beach. Boats may also be carried down the beach access tracks 16 and 17 from Mitchell Road to the beach.

Limited Trailer Parking (with cars attached) will be permitted in the northern council reserve at the corner of Hume and Mitchell Roads Cronulla.

Note 1: There is no council paid parking around Wanda Beach and parking right at the beach front can be limited at busy times.

Note 2: Parking is restricted to three hours available along sections of the seaward side of Mitchell Road. However, there is unrestricted parking on the western side of Mitchell Road and on other streets within 400 metres of the Wanda and Elouera Clubhouses.

Note 3: Access to the beach with trailers at Wanda SLSC will not be possible as it is main access hub for event organisation and emergency services. In addition, the parking directly in front of Wanda clubhouse will be strictly reserved for invited guests, store holders, for mobility parking permit holders (if there are sufficient spaces), and for emergency and service access only.
