INTRODUCTION 1.

Thank you for entering Wanda SLSC's 10th Annual Tradies "One Club" Carnival.

This Circular details some important information. Please take a moment to familiarise you with the content.

Our Club is looking forward to hosting your club, competitors, officials, water safety, and spectators and hope that all have a most enjoyable day.

This year events will again be conducted in the U8 to O40 age categories plus adaptive competition.

In an exciting development, Wanda is including Surf Boats and March Past (in all divisions) in the suite of events being conducted this year, all on the same day. These additional events round out Wanda's vision of its "One Club" carnival concept that encompasses all lifesaving sport discipline and participants aged from U8 to Masters.

In addition, for its 10th year, The Tradies Wanda One Surf Carnival will again be a 5000-point 'World Ocean Series' event that has attracted a number of elite age group and open Ironmen/women, and specialist competitors to our Carnival.

To best present the Carnival, conditions permitting, Wanda SLSC is planning a short "finals session" featuring eight great events commencing at 12 Noon. The Carnival should conclude at around 2:15pm.

Wanda SLSC was requested by SLSNSW to an early adopter and to utilise the new "Live Heats" entry system for its 10th Annual Tradies One Club Carnival. This has been a learning experience for all involved and appreciation is extended to all clubs for their cooperation. Appreciation is extended to all clubs for their cooperation in implementing Surf Life Saving's new carnival entry system.

In this regard please ensure that all entries are complete via the <u>Live Heats Wanda entry link</u> by 12:01am on Monday, 20 October 2025 in order to avoid any late entry fees – refer Section 4.

And, if not already undertaken please also complete the following "Must Do" registrations ASAP prior to the Carnival:

- Register JAG Water Safety Personnel for Clubs with the ratio of 1 water safety person per 7
 U8 -U13 aged competitors: Water Safety Registration Jot Form. Please also refer to Section
 9 of this Circular.
- Register IRB Driver/Crew Personnel for Clubs with more than 50 competitors: <u>IRB Driver</u>
 and <u>Crew Registration Jot Form</u>.
 Note: Wanda SLSC will provide the IRBs we just need drivers and crew. Please also refer to Section 10 of this Circular.
- **Nominate Carnival Officials** with the ratio of 1 Official per 15 competitors from each club: **Officials Nomination Form.** Please also refer to Section 11 of this Circular.

Note: To ensure that the Wanda One Club Carnival can be conducted safely and efficiently, and all have a great experience, Wanda will insist on clubs fulfilling these commitments as part of their participation in the Carnival.

And finally, competition shall be conducted as per the current edition SLSA Surf Sports Manual except where detailed in the Wanda One Entry Circular and other relevant SLS Circulars.

2. CARNIVAL PRECINCT AND PARKING

There is no council paid parking at Wanda Beach and parking right at the beach front can become limited at busy times.

Three hour parking is available along sections of the seaward side of Mitchell Road between Wanda and Elouera SLSCs and all day parking is available on the western side of the road and on other streets within comfortable walking distance from the Wanda SLSC Clubhouse.

Access to the car park directly behind Wanda SLSC clubhouse with cars and trailers will not be possible as it is the main access hub for event organisation and for emergency services. In addition, this car park will be strictly reserved for invited guests, store holders, for mobility parking permit holders (if there are sufficient spaces), and for emergency and service access only.

A Board and ski craft drop off zone will be established to the north of Sutherland Shire Council Lifeguard Centre adjacent to the Wanda Clubhouse.

Boat Trailers may be unloaded on the driveway at Elouera SLSC and carried on to the beach. Boats may also be carried down the beach access tracks 16 and 17 from Mitchell Road to the beach.

Notwithstanding restricted parking, trailers should not be parked on the seaward side of Mitchell road between Wanda and Elouera as they can be a hazard for pedestrian traffic.

Boat and Craft Trailer Parking (with or without tow vehicle attached) and designated Club Busses will be available on the northern reserve located on the corner of Hume and Mitchell Roads Cronulla.

Please follow and respect all directions of the Wanda SLSC parking assistance volunteers.

3. INFECTOUS DISEASE CONTROL

There are no particular infectious disease safety warnings or plans for this year's carnival other than a request that if any participant or spectator has tested positive to COVID or feels unwell in any way, please consider others, and do not attend the Carnival.

4. ENTRY FEES, LIVEHEATS ENTRY AND WRIST BANDS, AND PAYMENTS

Entries are to be made entries online for all events using the new SLSA Live Heats Entry System manager system. This is accessed via https://liveheats.com/Wanda. The standard entry fee are as follows:

- Entry fees of \$39.00 per individual competitor (covers all events) shall apply for the U9 to O40 years age groups.
- Entry fees of \$28:00 per individual competitor (covers all events) shall apply for the U8 years age group.
- Adaptive event participant entry fees are free of charge.
- With the exception of March Past, R&R and Surf Boats, there is no additional fee payable to enter team events if an participant is entered in individual events).
- R&R Team Entry of \$65.00 per Team for each event.
- March Past Entry fees of \$65 per team.
- Surf Boats Entry fees of \$65 per crew.

Please note:

- Normal entries for all events close at 12.01am on Monday 20 October 2025.
- Late Entries will remain open until 12.01am on Saturday, 25 October 2025 but will attract a late entry fee of \$20 in addition to the standard Entry Fees.
- Very Late Entries fees will apply from that time until 9am on Saturday, 25 October 2025 but will attract an additional \$15 fee on top of the \$20 late entry fee and the standard entry fee.
- All fees are payable by credit/debit card, or Apple Pay, or Google Pay at the time of entry on the Live Heats system.
- A direct transfer system is being established by Live Heats but is yet available to use.

Please refer to the Wanda SLSC Tradies "One Club" Carnival Entry Circular for further detail.

An "Assistance. Tent" (for very late entry assistance and to purchase Live Heats Wrist Bands) will be operational the Carnival Village and will be located on the grass Area located between the Wanda SLSC Clubhouse and the Sutherland Shire Council Lifeguard Centre.

The Assistance Tent will be operational from 6:15am and will close at 9:00am.

Surf Life Saving Sydney charges \$5.50 for a wrist band for those new competitors not previously registered with Live Heats. For those requiring a replacement wrist band the fee is \$11.00. The fee for a new or replacement wristband is in addition to the entry fee.

Please note LiveHeats bands will be required to worn by competitors in all individual and team events other than those competitors participating only in the R&R, March Past and Surf Boat events.

With the exception of those requiring seeking very late entry assistance, a new or replacement Live Heats wristband, or are seeking general information, all competitors may proceed directly to their respective areas and, wearing their Live Heats wristband, report for event marshalling when called.

For those new to Surf Life Saving competition, LiveHeats is a "real time" event management system that assists organisers to manage entries, determine the rounds of events, and final results etc. Participants may follow their progress in competition using Live heats and record their results. Live Heats will also be used to assist calculate the Tradies Club Point Score calculation.

5. BEACH SET UP

There has again been some sand erosion. Wanda SLSC requests the cooperation of all participants with club tent placement and craft storage.

8. COMPETITOR REPORT AND START TIMES

Event Registration for all events shall commence at 6:15 am.

Note: Wanda SLSC is hopeful of good conditions for competition. The tides are favourable and beach has returned but it still may be required to adjust the timing of some events. Every endeavour will be taken to communicate any major changes to participating clubs prior to the day of the Carnival.

9. JAG WATER SAFETY

All Clubs <u>must</u> provide proficient water safety personnel on a one to 7 competitor ratio for their U8-U13 (and U14 non SRC competitors) competitors. Other Competing Clubs are also requested to assist.

Note: Adaptive event participants entering the water will require one to one water safety provided by the competitor's club.

The Water Safety Coordinator is David Gumley (<u>watersafety@wandanippers.com.au</u>). To register your Water Safety participants (including Adaptive Competitor events) please go to the "Wanda One Carnival – Water Safety link located at: <u>Water Safety Registration</u>.

If required clubs will be requested to provide further assistance on the day to ensure there is sufficient water safety for competitors.

The main Water Safety Officials Briefing shall take place at 7:30am outside the Wanda SLSC Club House. Any further briefings and reporting shall be in the allocated water arenas.

When reporting for duty please remember to bring your own orange Water Safety rash shirt and cap and, if possible, it would be helpful to bring your rescue tube or board. Please also remember to bring protective clothing, sunscreen, and a water bottle (for refills).

Breakfast, morning tea, lunch (in the downstairs bar area) and a debrief will be offered to working water safety personnel at the end of all competition.

10. IRB ASSISTANCE

All Clubs with 50 or more competitors registered to compete <u>must</u> provide one proficient IRB Driver and Crew.

Note: There is no need to bring an IRB to the Carnival. Wanda SLSC will provide the IRBs – we just need drivers and crew.

The Water Safety Coordinator is Brett Porteous (irbcaptain@wandaslsc.com.au)

To register your IRB Driver and Crew please go to the "Wanda One Carnival – IRB Driver and Crew link located at: IRB Driver and Crew Registration.

The IRB Driver and Crew Briefing shall take place at 7:30am outside the Wanda SLSC Club House. Any further briefings and reporting shall be in the allocated water arenas.

When reporting for duty please remember to bring your Personal Protective Equipment (Wetsuit, Lifejacket, and Helmet, protective clothing, etc). as well as sunscreen, and a water bottle (for refills).

Breakfast, morning tea, lunch (in the downstairs bar area) and a debrief will be offered to working IRB personnel at the end of all water competition.

11. COMPETITION OFFICIALS

All competing Clubs must provide Officials on a one to 15 competitor ratio. The Referee is Carlo Villanti (carlocripple@outlook.com).

To register your officials please go to the "Wanda One Carnival Officials Nomination Form. Note: This form must be submitted by Friday, 19 October 2025

If required clubs will be requested to provide further assistance on the day to ensure there are sufficient officials to conduct the Carnival.

The Officials Briefings times and locations are detailed in Section 8.

When reporting for duty please remember to bring your bring protective clothing, name tag, sunscreen, and a water bottle (for refills).

Breakfast, morning tea, lunch (in the downstairs bar area) and a debrief will be offered to officials at the end of all competition.

12. CARNIVAL VILLAGE

The "Tradies One Club Carnival Village" is to be established on the grass between the Wanda Clubhouse and the Lifeguard Administration area.

In that area will be Assistance Tent. Event, the Club BBQ, Snow Cones, and stall holders from Engine and other Carnival supporters. The Wanda Café will be in operation and will be the coffee vendor.

Please take a moment to go to the village and support the Wanda Club, Stall Holders, BBQ, and Café.

In addition, winner's prizes will be available for collection in front of the clubhouse and, from about 12:30 pm at the conclusion of the Carnival, it is planned to have random sponsor and supporter product lucky draw giveaways including the major giveaway of a JBL Party Box.

13. MEDALS, PRIZES AND PRIZE MONEY

First, Second and Third place medallions will be offered to place getters in U9 to U13 age individual and team events. Voodoo Dri Caps will also be awarded to individual event winners.

Placing and Participation medals will also be offered for all U8 and adaptive participants.

Random Giveaway prizes will also be awarded to lucky competitors at the Carnival Village from about 12:30pm.

Please refer to the attached list for details of prizes and prize money for Open Age Events and the prizes for the U14 Ironman and Ironwoman.

Please Note that as per SLSNSW requirements relating to insurance, any prize money won must be paid to clubs. This will be attended to following the Carnival.

14. CLUBHOUSE ACCESS AND DOWNSTAIRS AREA

A private function has been booked for the upstairs Founders Room in the afternoon. As such no access will be permitted to the Room or the upstairs balcony area except for some morning access only by specially invited VIPs. Please respect this instruction.

A VIP viewing area in front of the Clubhouse will also be established for invited guests.

The downstairs area will be open from 12 noon and officials, water safety and all carnival work force are welcome to take a break for lunch and also attend following the conclusion of the carnival.

The usual licensing arrangements will also apply.

The area will cease operation at about 5:00pm.

15. SAFETY AND CONTINGENCY PLANS

Safety Plans have been prepared and are available upon request.

In the event of adverse conditions, the area around Silver Beach at Kurnell and Cronulla Beach (for JAG events only) have been identified as back-up venues. An assessment will be made in the days just prior to 25 October 2025 and, where possible, advance notice will be given to competing clubs via the contact email and social media.

The hierarchy of possible relocations are via the water competition from U9 and 10 through to U17, then Masters and finally Open competitors, and Surf Boats. It is anticipated that at least U14 to Masters beach events, March Past and R&R would remain at Wanda Beach.
